

Cyber Security and Technology Crime Bureau (CSTCB)

The Hong Kong Police Force is committed to combating technology crime. The Cyber Security and Technology Crime Bureau (CSTCB) is responsible for handling cyber security issues and carrying out technology crime investigations, computer forensic examinations and prevention of technology crime. CSTCB will also establish close liaison with local and overseas law enforcement agencies for combating cross-border technology crime and experience exchange.

To enhance coordination of the resources of the Force for combating related crimes and to further increase the awareness of the public on security, the Force has continued to set out combating technology crime as one of the Operational Priorities in 2014, and will strive to enhance cyber security and combat technology crime in the following three ways:

1. Promote public awareness of computer and cyber security as well as the risks associated with social media through a multi-agency approach.
2. Enhance cooperation with other law enforcement agencies to target technology crime.
3. Improve coordination and sharing of expertise in handling and investigating technology crime.
The Collaboration Teams of Cyber Security Division (Col CSD) under CSTCB is responsible for the formulation and implementation of crime prevention programmes on technology crime in order to raise the awareness of technology crime prevention amongst the general public.
