CERT Australia is the national computer emergency response team, working with major Australian businesses, providing cyber security advice and support to critical infrastructure and other systems of national interest.

CERT Australia works closely with other Australian Government agencies and international CERTs, to provide Australian businesses with the best advice possible, as soon as possible. It is also a key element in the Australian Cyber Security Centre, sharing information and working closely with the Australian Security Intelligence Organisation, the Australian Federal Police, the Australian Signals Directorate, the Defence Intelligence Organisation and the Australian Crime Commission.
