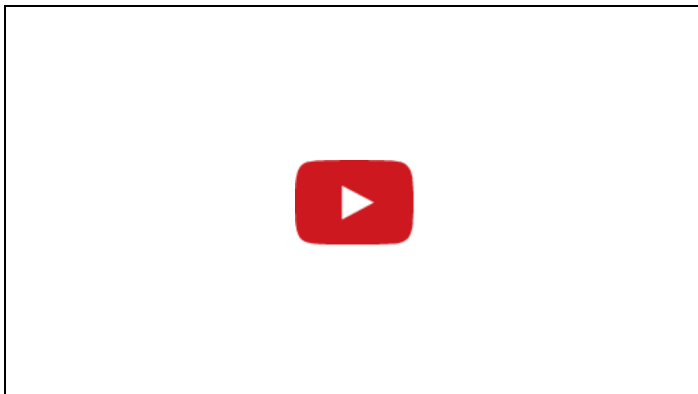
Scope

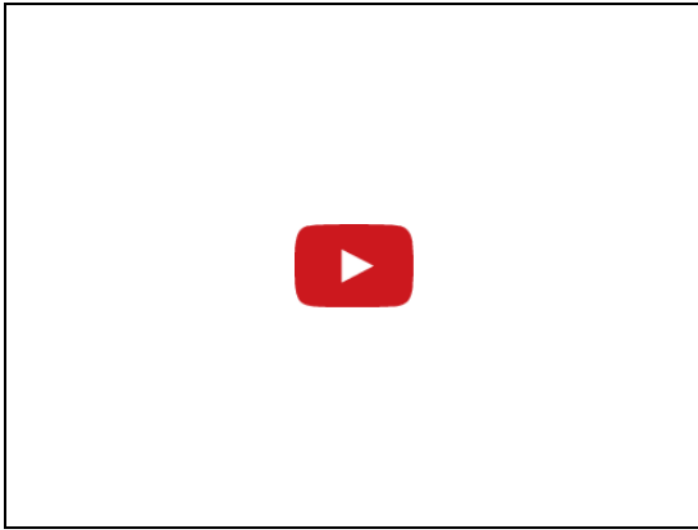
It acts as a catalyst for:

- Enabling them through the awarding of prizes as training courses.

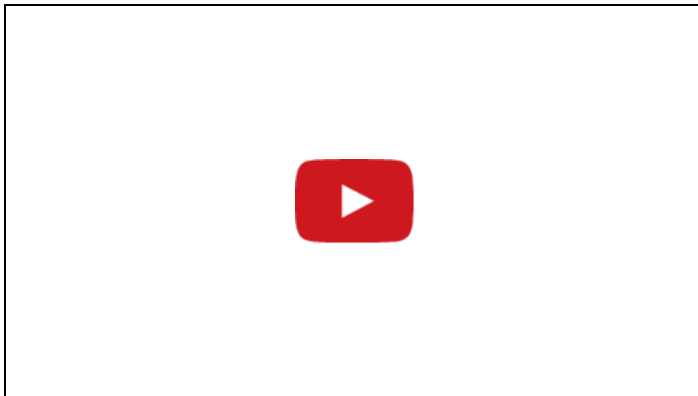
