### 48 Causing or inciting child prostitution or pornography

**[F1]**(1) A person (A) commits an offence if—

- (a) he intentionally causes or incites another person (B) to become a prostitute, or to be involved in pornography, in any part of the world, and
- (b) either—
  - (i) B is under 18, and A does not reasonably believe that B is 18 or over, or
  - (ii) B is under 13.

(2) A person guilty of an offence under this section is liable—

- (a) on summary conviction, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months or a fine not exceeding the statutory maximum or both;
- (b) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 14 years.]
