Introduction

Welcome to the pages of the *CSIRT.CZ* team - *The National CSIRT Team of the Czech Republic*. *CSIRT.CZ* (CSIRT = Computer Security Incident Response Team) is a name of the security team which coordinates security incident solving in the computer networks of the *Czech Republic*.

The *CSIRT.CZ* goal is to help Internet Service Providers in the *Czech Republic* founding their own Security Incident Response teams as well as their security infrastructure, solving security incidents and thus improving the security of their own networks as well as of the global Internet.

CSIRT.CZ also helps delivering security incident reports to the administrators of networks or domains where the incidents originated but whose administrators do not respond. In a sense, one can say that *CSIRT.CZ* acts as a "Last resort institution" when all regular forms of contacting appropriate administrators fail.

Security team *CSIRT.CZ* operates the CZ.NIC association, administrator of the Czech national domain, on the basis of the [memorandum](http://www.csirt.cz/files/nic/doc/NBU_Memorandum_12-12-A.pdf) concluded in 2012 with the National Security Authority.
