ADMINISTRATIVE RULE NO. 45, SEPTEMBER 8, 2009.

It establishes, in the scope of the Chamber of Foreign Affairs and National Defense (CREDEN), the Technical Team of Cybernetic Safety and other provisions.

THE STATE MINISTER, HEAD OF THE INSTITUTIONAL SAFETY DEPARTMENT OF THE PRESIDENCY OF THE REPUBLIC, in the use of his attributions and in light of the provided in article 4 of Decree no 4.801, of August 06, 2003, the authorization of His Excellency the President of the Republic and the deliberation of the Executive Committee of the Chamber of Foreign Affairs and National Defense (CREDEN), in a meeting held on October 08, 2008, **CONSIDERING:**

the information discussed in the scope of the Federal Public Administration as valuable assets of the nation, in the new world conception of safety and efficiency of the State.

the increasing use of information and communication technology resources in the provision of public services as a democratic tool needed for the citizen access to the government information, granting a higher transparency to the management of the State, at the same time that increase the vulnerability and attack attempts to the governmental networks and databases, affecting the Federal Public Administration;

the increasing of threats and cybernetic attack attempts, which include potential attacks to governmental networks and databases, affecting the Federal Public Administration;

the need to ensure, inside the cybernetic space, information safety actions to assure availability, integrity, confidentiality and authenticity of information and communication in the scope of the Federal Public Administration;

the real possibility of the use of computer means for offensive actions against the computer networks of strategic institutions of the Brazilian Government.

IT SETTLES:

Article. 1 – It is established the Technical Team of Cybernetic Safety with the purpose to propose guidelines and strategies for the Cybernetic Safety, in the scope of the Federal Public Administration.

Article. 2 It is considered Cybernetic Safety the skill to assure the existence and the continuity of the Information Community of a Nation, assuring and protecting, in the Cybernetic Environment, its Information Assets and its Critical Infrastructures.

§ 1 The storage, transmission and processing means, the information systems, as well as the places where these means are found and the personnel that have access to them, are Information Assets.

§ 2 The facilities, services, goods and systems that, if suspended or destroyed, will cause serious social, economical, political and international impact to the safety of the State or to the society, are Critical Infrastructures.

Article. 3 The Technical Team will be composed by two representatives, officer and substitute, of each of the following agencies:

I – Institutional Safety Department of the Presidency of the Republic, that will coordinate, by means of the Communication and Information Safety Department;

II – Ministry of Justice;

III – Ministry of Defense

IV – Ministry of Foreign Affairs;

V – *Comando da Marinha* (Navy Leadership);

VI – *Comando do Exército* (Army Leadership);

VII - *Comando da Aeronáutica* (Aeronautics Leadership).

§ 1 The Technical Team may, when needed, invite and interact with the agencies and specialists for the provision of information and adoption of necessary measures to the complement of the activities established by this Administrative Rule.

§ 2 The necessary measures and actions will be reported to the Chamber of Foreign Affairs and National Defense, by mediation of its Coordinator.

Article. 4 The members of the Technical Team will be indicated by the head managers of the agencies mentioned in article 3, in the term of third days, as of the date of publication of this Administrative Rule.

Sole paragraph. The appointment of the representatives that the *caput* attend must fulfill the technical profile required.

Article. 5 The Technical Team will be established in the term of fifteen days after the appointment of its members.

Article. 6 The Technical Team will meet in an ordinary meeting once a month and, in an extraordinary meeting when summoned by its Coordinator.

Article. 7 The Participation of the Technical Team provided by this Administrative Rule will be considered of a relevant public interest and non-remunerated.

Article. 8 The Institutional Safety Department will be responsible to provide the administrative support and means necessary for the execution of the tasks of the Technical Team.

Article. 9 This Administrative Rule will be enforced in its date of publication.
