CSIRT - computer security incident response team is a specialized organization responsible for preventing, analyzing, identifying and reacting to cybernetic incidents.

CERT-RO is the national contact point for similar structures.

CERT-RO is responsible for elaborating and distributing public policies for prevention and counteracting the incidents that occur within cyber infrastructures.

CERT-RO analyzes technical and procedural problems within cyber infrastructures.

CERT-RO is managed by a general director and a deputy director, both supported by the Coordination Committee:

- a) Ministry of Communication and Informational Society;
- b) Ministry of National Defense;
- c) Ministry of Administration and Interior;
- d) Romanian Intelligence Service (SRI);

- e) Foreign Intelligence Service (SIE);
- f) Special Telecommunications Service (STS);
- g) Guard and Protection Service (SPP);
- h) National Registry Office for Classified Information;
- i) National Authority for Management and Regulation in Communications.

In order to fulfill the attributions of CERT-RO, the general director is responsible for decision making and instructions.
