The National Cyber Security Center (NCSC) Is the Central point of government for Identifying, preventing and responding to cyber attacks and threats In korea. The NCSC, In collaboration with the private sector and the military sector, will Improve warning systems and response time to security incidents and protect critical national Infrastructures In Korea.

The NCSC Is responsible for the following

- Preventing cyber attacks
- Analyzing and reducing cyber threats and vulnerabilities
- Disseminating threat warning information through alerts and warnings
- Coordinating cyber emergency response activities

The NCSC will

- Enhance prevention efforts by developing and distributing advisories and guidelines that provide the best practices to protect Information resources
- Operate a Monitoring Room year-round,24/7 to improve warning systems and response time
- Conduct Intrusion and defense simulation exercise In order to respond to "Information Warfare"
- Perform security checks and diagnose potential threats to the national information Infrastructure
- Share information with partners from the private/public/military sectors based on a mutually agreed set of data sharing principles
